Chairman's Report 2025.

On behalf of our committee members, I welcome you all to the Annual General meeting (AGM) of Berkshire Athletics. The medals and trophies of the Berkshire Road Running Championships have now been presented to those worthy individuals, and we give them all our hearty congratulations.

There are reports from each of our committee secretaries providing details of our Berkshire athletes and teams over the past 12 months in representative events and at the county competitions which we organise and run. Without the dedication of our committee members, and of the many officials and helpers Berkshire cannot organise and run our county events nor then be able to choose athletes to represent Berkshire in Sports Hall, regional and Inter-County championships. With that thought in mind we have in the last 12 months looked for new members to join the committee and, most importantly, to appoint a Track and Field secretary. Malcolm Charlish has held that position for many, many years (well before I joined the committee in 2013) and gave us notice that 2025 would be his last year as T&F secretary. Unless we can appoint a replacement for him potentially there will be no Berkshire T&F championships in 2026. On behalf of the committee and of Berkshire Athletics I thank Malcolm for his commitment, time and dedication to Berkshire Athletics' Track and Field competition.

I also thank all the committee members, and schools' representative for without your dedication to Berkshire Athletics socially and actively Berkshire would be all the poorer. On behalf of us all I thank Andrew Mair who has worked with Leila Oliver (General Secretary) to create our new website. Andrew has supported us, behind the scenes, in updating and resolving problems, with our website for several years. Committee members also hold important positions in many of our athletic, road running and off-road clubs. They hold qualifications as officials and regularly attend athletics meetings both locally, nationally and internationally. Field and Track officials' courses are now held online, and they take about four hours of your time to complete one of them. Road running clubs may consider encouraging their members to complete an Endurance technical officials' course to provide race referees for our local EA licenced road and cross-country events. Therefore, I would encourage anyone interested in taking an official's course to apply now. All our affiliated clubs' welcome new members, not always as an active athlete but as someone who can help run our clubs, possibly as a coach, an official or in administration. Why not 'give it a go'!

On Saturday December 13th, 2025, at Dinton Pastures (old golf course), we are holding our County Cross Country Championships. This is a new course, created by members of Reading Athletic Club, and there will be good competition in all age groups. Details are available on our website.

## BERKSHIRE ATHLETICS TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS 10 MAY/11 MAY 2025 JOHN NIKE STADIUM BRACKNELL

Quotes for track hire were requested and received from Bracknell Leisure Centre and Thames Valley Athletic Centre. Palmer Park was not available due to resurfacing of the track. After considering the two quotes, Bracknell Leisure Centre £2427.60 and Thames Valley Athletic Centre £3451 + VAT, the Committee decided on Bracknell.

Entries were once again very high with 415 entrants. There was approx. 10% no show over the two days.

Two days of good Championship competition with 8 new Championship Best Performances

There were two problems which arose on the Saturday.

The first being that when it came to the first steeplechase the water was found not to be up to the required depth. Was thought that somebody had tampered with the drain plug. The problem was resolved with the agreement of the athletes that it be rescheduled for later in the timetable once the water had been topped up.

The other problem was of my making. I hit a wrong button on the Roster system and deleted all the bib numbers previously allocated to athletes. After the initial panic and no way to recover the numbers the only solution for the Saturday was to issue new numbers to athletes as they checked in. This was done but caused a queue of athletes waiting to register for their events but did not result in any missing their event or cause any delay to events.

On the Saturday evening I reissued numbers on Roster for athletes who were only competing on Sunday.

## BERKSHIRE ATHLETICS AGM – NOVEMBER 2025 – XC REPORT

The County XC Championships were held successfully on Hungerford Common on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2024, after cancellation the previous year.

231 entered, compared to 237 when the event last took place, in 2022.

183 finished (79% of entries), compared to 184 (78%) last time.

Due to the different age groups used for the Inter-Counties XC Championships, for which the County Champs are a qualifier, some U20 men and women opted to run as seniors.

Four athletes auto-qualified for the Berkshire team as per the selection rules – Frank McGrath and Eva Bartlett, both U20, and senior women Mia Waldmann and Izzy Fry had all competed at the Euros. Eva Bartlett accepted her place in the Berkshire team (but was later unable to compete).

## BERKSHIRE SCHOOLS AA AGM REPORT NOVEMBER 2025

Berkshire Schools has had a busy year celebrating its centenary and providing many different competitive events both on the country and track

The year began with the cross country championships held in January at the Newbury Showground. There were 103 runners in the Under 13 Boys with Noah Maziers finishing first. Reading Blue Coat were the clear winners. 125 Under 13 girls took part where Simone Piewman was the first home. Wellington College team were 5 points ahead of Charters team. Hannah Lucas from Bohunt won the junior girls and Holt were the first team. Elliot Langley Ayboa from Emmbrook school led the field of 109 Junior boys and Reading Blue Coat were team winners. In the Inter boys Josh Norton from Kennet School was the winner and Reading Blue Coat team were first one point from Eton College. Clear winner of the Inter Girls was Piggot's Lizzie Sheridan and Newlands won the team event. A mere one second separated seniors Eton's Alex Wilson and Reading Bluecoat's Dylan Bavazzano, Eton were the only team to close in out of the 22 finishers. In the senior girls there were 14 crossing the line with Holt's Marnie Fieldsend the gold medallist.

The South East Inter Counties cross country championships was hosted also at the Newbury Showground. The most successful team was the Junior Girls in 5<sup>th</sup> place. Athletes from this meeting were selected to represent Berkshire in the ESAA championships at Ardingly, East Sussex. Elliott was selected to compete for England in the Home International in Scotland where he had an excellent run finishing in 6<sup>th</sup> place and helping England to win gold medals.

The county round of the Combined events took place at Bracknell and was well supported. Teams were selected to progress to the SE round. William Alexander was runner up in the Senior boys' event and Oliver Hall finished in 4<sup>th</sup>. The team came 1<sup>st</sup>. At the ESAA final at Chelmsford William was a worthy winner and the team ended up in a well deserved 2<sup>nd</sup> place

The county track and field championships were held at Bracknell this year as Palmer Park was unavailable. There were several championship best performances with Imogen Nation taking almost 2 seconds off the record in the Junior Girls 800 m. Izzy Rae in the Inter girls 80m hurdles, Isabella Winslade, Inter Girls triple jump, Chummy Anthony Uzoeto senior boys shot all achieved championship best performances.

A team of 70 athletes were selected to compete in the ESAA championships in Birmingham and Berkshire had four winners, Izzy Rae, 80m Hurdles, Ella Davey 1500m Steeple chase, Chummy Anthony Uzoeto shot and Kahlon Nneke Senior boys' triple. There were over 20 athletes who finished in the first six of their events and many achieved a national or entry standard. The highest placed team in fourth position was the senior boys and the Junior and Senior girl teams were both fifth.

In the SIAB meeting in Scotland Izzy Rae representing England and was the runner up in the 80m hurdles.

In conclusion I would like to thank all our county officials and teachers who have provide a high level of support which enables all our athletes results to appear in the Power of 10 ranking lists. Thanks also to Newbury AC for their help at the cross country meetings and Bracknell for all their help providing much appreciated lunches.
